

focus group session two: finding out what young people thought of the LHHE session

Intro:

5 mins

Explain the idea behind the follow-up focus group and how the group's feedback will influence LHHE in their school/group

Open questions to the whole group: what did you think of the session on leaving home and housing?

10 mins

- Using a flipchart, ask the group to shout out the things they really enjoyed about the LHHE session. Then ask them to shout out the things they didn't like so much.
- Go through the main parts of the LHHE session, using one sheet for each part, e.g. if you did a case study, what did they think of it; if they received information to take away did they find it useful, etc.

Group work: Team quiz

15 mins

- Devise a quiz based on the main points of your LHHE session. Split the group into small groups or pairs and get them to name their team.
- Do the quiz with them then ask them to swap their answer sheets with another group for marking. You can give the winners a prize if you like.
- Go over the answers, discussing the ones people got wrong and taking note of any gaps in their knowledge.

Evaluation

- Ask each member of the group to fill in an evaluation sheet on the LHHE session .

Thank the group for taking part and explain to them what you will do with the information. If you change any material because of the group's input, arrange for them to either see the material or send it to them.
